Objectives

2. Students will be able to identify the learning style that is best and the one that is most difficult for them.
3. Students will understand Gardner's Theory of Multiple Intelligences.
4. After identifying their predominant learning style and how they are intelligent, the students will be able to give examples of how this information can help them become more successful.
5. Students will understand that having a disability does not mean that a person is dumb or cannot do things; it just means that they may need to find a different way to do a task.
6. Students will be able to approach a teacher in a positive and non-threatening way to ask for a modification or assistance with a lesson.
7. Students will be able to identify some people with disabilities who have had successful careers.
8. Students will be able to set at least one positive goal for themselves.
