

EFFECTS OF TOBACCO

Lesson Format

Day One

1. Prep before class (Pages 6, 7).
2. Tobacco Overview information (Teacher Script Day #1 - Pages 7, 8).
3. Conduct Smoking Lung Lab Experiment (Teacher Script Day #1 - Pages 9-10).
4. Have students complete the ***Smoking Lung Science Report*** (Page 21, 22) or the ***Smoking Lung Writing Response*** activity (Page 23) in class. This can be accomplished individually, in pairs or in small groups.
5. Have the class read the storybook titled ***A Little Mouse Told Me***.
6. Discuss the handout ***Some of the Many Ingredients Found in Tobacco*** (Page 25).
7. If you have access to the internet - - Complete the ***C.A.I -Cigarette Additive Investigators Research Activity*** (Page 26).
8. For homework or additional in class work, have students complete the ***Nicotine and Smoking Word Find*** (Page 27) or the ***Some of the Ingredients Found in Tobacco Word Find*** (Page 29).

Day Two

1. Prep before class (Pages 12, 13).
2. Review homework and the science report or writing response worksheets.
3. Read over the ***Facts About Tobacco handout*** (Pages 18, 19).
4. Conduct the Tar Jar Activity following the lesson plan provided (Teacher Script Day #2 – Page 14-15).
5. Have students complete the ***Tar Jar Science Report*** (Page 31) or the ***Tar Jar Writing Response*** activity in class (Page 32). This can be accomplished individually, in pairs or in small groups.
6. Mr. Gross Mouth Video and discussion.
7. Discuss marketing strategies used by tobacco industry.
8. Pass out the ***As Soon as You Quit Smoking handout*** for students (Page 20).
9. Administer the “Test Your Knowledge” Quiz (Page 37).
10. For homework, have students complete the ***Expense of Tobacco worksheet(s)*** (Pages 33, 34).
